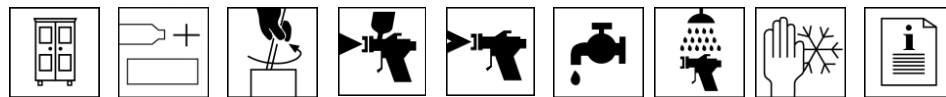


ADLER Aqua-Tint

Product description

Water-thinnable colorant concentrates with good light-fastness and high brilliance.

All concentrates of this range can be mixed with one another in any ratio, so that a wide colour spectrum range can be achieved.

Application areas

For tinting water-thinnable furniture coatings,

- when the wood structure is to be enhanced with natural surfaces and an appearance similar to solvent-based coatings enhancing the natural wood grain, colour and texture (for example ADLER Tiropur) is required.
- when the selected color on stained surfaces is to be deepened or slightly changed.

Application

If clear coatings are to be tinted, this is normally only applied to the topcoat.

To ensure easy application of tinted coatings the colour contrast to the substrate must not be too extreme.

When coating natural surfaces or very light stained substrates, an addition of 0.1-1.0 percent in weight to the topcoat is recommended.

With dark woods and dark stained surfaces the quantity added may be increased to up to 5 percent in weight.

Fine-grained deciduous woods (leaf wood) such as cherry, beech, alder, etc. in particular are often varnished with tinted topcoats. For this application area the special concentrates such as ADLER Aqua-Tint "Medium" or ADLER Aqua-Tint "Cherry" are designed. An addition of approx. 1 percent in weight is recommended as standard guideline.

Before starting the coating application, always test the coating on the original substrate in order to verify the application properties of the selected color and the finish. With good color matching with the substrate to be coated, the tinted coating may be used both as primer and as topcoat in exceptional cases.
